Dr. von Davier is credited as one of the earliest proponents of the field of Computational Psychometrics, which is defined as a blend of psychometrics and AI that is frequently concerned with providing actionable and meaningful feedback to individuals based on measurement and analysis of individual differences as they pertain to specific areas of enquiry.

Nevada Broadens Its Privacy Law...what are the implications?

Amendments to the Nevada Privacy of Information Collected on the Internet from Consumers Act have become effective on October 1, 2021, setting out new requirements for the collection of covered information by websites. Covered information includes personally identifiable information collected through a website or online service and maintained by an operator or data broker in an accessible form, such as (1) first and last name; (2) physical address; (3) email or phone number; (4) social security number; (5) an identifier allowing a specific person to be contacted physically or online; or (6) any other information in combination with an identifier in a form that makes the information available.
